

Canosia Township Recreational Area 2014

The Canosia Township Recreational Area had another successful year. We didn't make a lot of changes for the year but we have some definite plans for 2015. We hope to make some changes to the tennis area and basketball court and hopefully the front baseball dugouts.

The front baseball field was used a lot. It was primarily used by the younger children of our community. This is where we hope to be able to make changes to the dugouts. The back baseball field was used regularly by the Proctor baseball team. They used it on a regular basis with the yardage 75 feet between the bases versus 60 feet eventually going to 90 feet. It is used as a transition field.

The U-6 field is on the front baseball field. It is used after the baseball season is finished. The U-8 and U-10 field was used quite a bit and the fields are in pretty good shape. Both fields are primarily used in the fall of the year.

The tennis courts and baseball court are due to be refinished. We are going to look at that this year. Hopefully, we can get a deal that accomplishes what we want. We hope to be able to firm something up in May or June of this year. The new nets have been put on hold until we get a new surface.

The volleyball court seems like it is getting a little more use than the previous years. We would like to see it used more but the usage seems to be picking up.

The ice skating rink wasn't used at all this year. Because of the warm temperatures it didn't get any use. It certainly is frustrating not to get any use on the skating rink.

We only had one bathroom for the season and it seemed to keep up. However we occasionally get some people who like to tip the bathroom over. Hopefully this will come to an end.

Our new lawn mower seemed to work just fine. It is cutting at a much quicker rate than our old one.

We have put a new roof on the skating rink and storage facility. This took a couple of week to get done in September.
